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**NOTICE TO DP WORLD CUSTOMERS
EARLY RECEIVAL PROCEDURE AND TERMINAL TARIFF**

Customers are advised that effective from **11th January 2016**, the following revised charges will apply for DP World Australia (DPWA) Early Receptions.

- **\$104.00 per container plus \$10.40 per day storage from the day of receipt until the commencement of the Agreed Receipt Period**
- **The tariffs stated exclude GST**

The Early Receipt Terminal Tariff is applicable to all full and empty export containers received before the commencement of the Agreed Receipt Period for the nominated Vessel, by prior agreement up to a maximum of eight (8) days prior to nominated Vessels' Cut-off.

The Early Receipt Procedures and Tariffs are applicable at the following sites;

Sydney	DPW Port Botany Terminal
Brisbane	DPW Fisherman Islands Terminal
Melbourne	DPW West Swanson Terminal
Fremantle	DPW Fremantle Terminal

Early Receipt Policy and Procedure:

Requests for early receipts are subject to agreement from DPWA and costs as per the tariff schedule outlined above will apply. The party requesting and confirming acceptance of costs for the Early Receipt will be invoiced directly for all Early Receipt Charges.

In the event an Early Receipt is required, the following procedure will apply:

1. An Early Receipt Request (ERR) must be lodged and receive approval a minimum of 48 hours prior to the container arrival.
2. An ERR must be lodged through the Special Service Request (SSR) system.
3. ERR's must be accompanied by a lodged ERA / PRA.
4. ERR's will not be considered for containers arriving more than eight days before the cut-off of the nominated Vessel.
5. DPWA will respond to the request via the SSR system advising if the request has been accepted or rejected.
6. Once the Early Receipt arrangements are confirmed and the party requesting the ERR has accepted the applicable charges the Operator will arrange receipt of the container into the Terminal.

No guarantee will be given that early receipts will be accepted. All charges are deemed accepted on completion of the SSR procedure as outlined above.
