**NOTICE TO DP WORLD CUSTOMERS  
SECURITY LEVY**

Customers are advised that effective from **1 July 2019** the DP World Australia Security Levy will be amended to reflect the increased costs associated with providing security in accordance with legislation requirements.

The current Security Levy was introduced on 1 January 2005 to recover compliance costs incurred by DP World Australia Ltd as a result of the introduction of the Maritime Security Act 2003. The levy applied is based on compliance with Level 1 of the International Ship and Port Security Code.

The Maritime Security Levy effective from **1 July 2019** will be;

**A\$7.60 plus GST per full container excluding transshipment containers**

The Maritime Security Levy is applicable at DP World leasehold facilities in the following Ports;

Brisbane	DPWA Fisherman Islands
Sydney	DPWA Port Botany Terminal
Melbourne	DPWA West Swanson Terminal
Fremantle	DPWA Fremantle Terminal

The Maritime Security Levy is not applicable to transshipment or empty containers.

DP World Australia reserves the right to review the Maritime Security Levy.
